Founded in 1992, Casa Montes is one of the most dynamic and fastest growing winery in San Juan, the second largest wine producing province in Argentina. This family owned cellar was conceived to produce high quality wines at excellent prices. Casa Montes produces 2 million liters per year of 11 different varieties of grapes.

Casa Montes offers a new concept in the wine business of Argentina by investing in its own province, by helping people with its fund raising program “Help People Future” <http://www.helppeoplesfuture.com/> and by minimizing the environment impact through the protection of a reservoir of natural forests of bicentennial carob trees. Casa Montes is placed as an important representative in the world of wines for the incoming years.

This is an elegant wine of intense purple tones and defined body, has been obtained through the Petit Verdot, perhaps the most exotic grape of Burdeos.

In the mouth is sweet and delicate, with floral notes; it can also been identified black cherries, blackberries, plums and raspberries, all of them covered by those typical scents provided by the ageing of 9 months in new French oak barrels, like vanilla and chocolate.

Creamy and unique, it is a perfect accompaniment to grilled red meats, good prosciutto and matured cheeses.
