Bodega Vistalba is a family vineyard located in the beautiful surroundings of Vistalba, one of the oldest cultivated areas in the Province of Mendoza, and is dedicated to creating premium wines, both elegant and complex with outstanding quality. In an environment with the perfect combination of winemaking, dining, tasting and relaxing.

Bodega Vistalba is the *only* winery in Argentina that has been awarded four times with 90+ Points, by Robert Parker of the Wine Advocate during 2010.

Rubi red color with complex and spicy aromas. In the mouth it has a sweet entrance, with structured tannins; gentle and persistent finish.

An ideal accompaniment for red meat dishes, pasta and cheeses.

This wine is 80% aged in stainless steel tanks and 20% in French oak barrels during 8 months. Then it is bottled and aged for another 6 months before it is released into the market.
