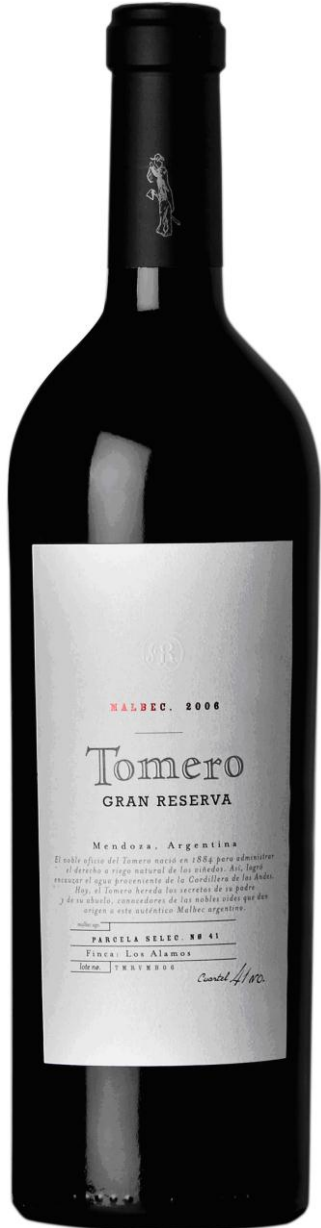




BODEGA VISTALBA GRAN RESERVE MALBEC 2007

Mendoza, Argentina



Bodega Vistalba is a family-owned winery located in the beautiful surroundings of Vistalba, one of the oldest cultivated areas in the Province of Mendoza, and is dedicated to creating premium wines, both elegant and complex with outstanding quality. In an environment with the perfect combination of winemaking, dining, tasting and relaxing.

Bodega Vistalba is the *only* winery in Argentina that has been awarded four times with 90+ Points, by Robert Parker of the Wine Advocate during 2010.

Gran Reserva Malbec was aged for 20 months in new French oak. It is a glass-coating opaque purple with a nose of pain grille, pencil lead, violets, black cherry, and plum. Supple and smooth-textured on the palate, notes of tobacco, leather, and chocolate emerge to add complexity. It has excellent grip, ripeness, and depth as well as 2-3 years of aging potential. Drink this first-class effort from 2012 to 2025.

An ideal accompaniment for red meat dishes, pasta and cheeses.

This wine is 100% aged in French oak barrels during 207 months. Then bottled on February 27th and aged at 12C for another 9 months before it is released into the market.
